BV30H *	Mojo	Sounds very similar to the Celestion G12H. Mojo sourced the original soft parts (cone, spider, dust cover) from the correct British source and then had their own baskets and magnet assemblies tooled in the US, resulting in an American made speaker with a British sound that is unmistakable.	Base
Greyhound	Mojo	Between the British Sound and the American Vintage sound, bright and articulate with less top end buzz than a Celestion Vintage 30. It's got a great rock tone but stays clean for those who don't like speaker break-up.	Base
G12H (30 watt)	Celestion	Densely complex and buttery mid-range and a finely detailed top-end, the G12H is excellent for cranking out huge, dark power chords, with smooth and rich bridge pickup tones and flutey neck pickup tones.	+\$33
M75 (65 watt)	Scumback	Factory aged, warm, detailed midrange with smooth overdrive and distortion tones. This is a superb tone and sound recreation of the G12M Pre Rola era "Greenback" offered in 65 watt version for less breakup and cone cry.	+\$82
